An informational guide to shipping all sizes of ACID Magic

GENERAL PRODUCT SHIPPING INFORMATION

Although ACID Magic ships "**ORM-D CONSUMER COMMODITY**" in the gallon and quart size larger sizes are considered a hazardous material "**HAZMAT**" and must be packaged according to 49 CFR, 173.203 Non-bulk packaging for liquid hazardous materials in Packing Group III. The shipping class is 70 for all sizes. The 5 gallon size and above are considered CORROSIVE (class 8), UN1760, NMFC#44155.04.

ACID Magic is packaged by Certol International in 7 different sizes and formats. Below is a complete description of the sizes offered, including unit and pallet dimensions.

SHIPPING QUARTS AND GALLONS ORM-D

Because of reduced safety risks associated with ACID Magic, DOT regulations allow it to be shipped as an ORM-D Consumer Commodity, when packaged in the one gallon size or smaller. The guidelines laid out below are designed to assist in meeting DOT requirements. As long as these requirements are met, quarts and gallons of ACID Magic can ship ORM-D, whether shipping a case of product, or a truckload of cases.

Consumer Commodity Packaging and Shipping Guidelines:

- **A. PALLET PACKAGING:** The product must be packaged in case boxes suitable for pallet size shipments. Boxes are designed for normal shipping conditions when transported by truck in pallet size loads.
- **B. PROPER ORM-D LABELING:** Case boxes must be properly marked using the ORM-D Consumer Commodity sticker, case labels and up arrows.
- **C. NO "UN RATED" BOXES:** Case boxes cannot be "UN Rated" when shipping ORM-D. You should not place an ORM-D Consumer Commodity in a "UN Rated" box because DOT regulations state if you do so, the product is automatically considered hazardous.
- **D. OVER BOXING WHEN SHIPPING VIA SMALL PACKAGE:** UPS, FedEx and other small package carriers can be rough on packaging and damage can occur during transport. To avoid unwanted headaches, Certol strongly recommends that additional safeguards be taken when shipping via small package carriers. To prevent damage to containers, place the case box in an additional sturdy and properly labeled outer box (not "UN Rated") to prevent damage during shipment with small package carriers.
- **E. OVER BOXED GOODS MUST CONTAIN PROPER LABELING:** over boxed cases must be properly marked using the ORM-D Consumer Commodity sticker, case labels and up arrows. Certol can provide assistance with labeling. Please contact customer Service for details.

F. PAPERWORK REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Regular Ground Shipments for ORM-D Consumer Commodity designated products do not require any special paper work, whether it goes by truck or small carrier like UPS, FedEx, etc.
- 2. Air Shipments for ORM-D Consumer Commodity designated products require a "Shipper's Declaration for Dangerous Goods" form to be completed. Accessorial charges apply for air shipments, and can be exorbitant. It is recommended that rate quotes be obtained prior to shipment.
- **G. INTERNATIONAL SHIPMENTS INCLUDING CANADA AND MEXICO:** Canada and Mexico do not recognize the ORM-D Consumer Commodity designation. This means the quarts and gallons are treated just like any other hazardous shipment. Therefore, to ship ACID Magic quarts or gallons internationally, the product must be re-boxed in a "UN Rated Fiberboard Box 4G." See 49 CFR section 173.203 Non-Bulk Packaging for Liquid Hazardous Materials in Packaging Group III for packaging guidelines.
- H. SHIPPING TO PO BOXES: Information on PO Box shipments is available on http://www.usps.com.
- I. OTHER RESTRICTIONS MAY APPLY: Contact local carrier offices for other shipping requirements.

SHIPPING 5 GALLON SIZES AND LARGER

Quantities packaged greater than 1 gallon are considered HAZMAT and all handling and shipment of these larger sizes must follow DOT regulations.

- **A. PACKAGING:** ACID Magic sizes greater than one gallon must always be placed in the appropriate UN Rated container. If you have signed the appropriate repackaging agreement with Certol and currently repackage ACID Magic, it is your responsibility to ensure that containers used are UN Rated.
- **B. LABELING:** Proper markings and labels must be placed on containers to indicate this is a Corrosive hazard. Special paperwork is also required. Anyone who repackages ACID Magic **MUST** use ACID Magic brand product labels supplied by Certol. Labels are provided free of charge. Contact Customer service for details.
- **C. HAZMAT TRAINING**: Shipping personnel are required by the DOT to be properly trained by the company who is handling the shipping of ACID Magic. DOT requires all companies who ship hazardous shipments to be properly trained.
- **D. PLACARDING:** Trucks and vans carrying shipments of ACID Magic that meet certain size and weight restrictions must be properly placarded. Improperly placarded trucks can receive stiff penalties under law. Consult with your local DOT official for specific requirements.
